Next Steps to Repair the OMBC

The *For The Players* Committee recently polled OMBC players regarding steps to resolve the governance problems at the OMBC. 91% of the responses urged the Committee to take action.

Since last December, we have attempted to negotiate in good faith with the Board. As no progress has been made, we are forced to pursue other avenues to cure problems at the OMBC. Our first step, as urged by OMBC players, will be to go to the City to discuss the lease agreement and the non-profit status of the OMBC. In preparation for the meeting with the City, we have collected signatures from 171 OMBC players supporting the following:

**“I play at the OMBC and pay game fees.
I would like to have a voice at the OMBC by voting in Board elections.”**

The Committee’s proposals to remedy governance problems at the OMBC are simple: comply with the OMBC’s Articles of Incorporation, give players the opportunity to become members and vote in Board elections. Additionally, prohibit owners of games from serving on the Board to avoid conflicts of interest. If the Board is prepared to address the governance problems at the OMBC, we are happy to expedite negotiations. Until then, we will pursue any and all means to repair the OMBC.
